



Northern Circle Indian Housing Authority accepts applications from enrolled tribal members from those tribes that currently have a Rental Assistance Program.

Applications are available at NCIHA and are accepted continuously throughout the year. Depending on the availability of funds there may be a waiting list for assistance.

Northern Circle Member Tribes with a Rental Assistance Program are:

- RedwoodValley Sherwood Valley
- Hopland Berry Creek
- Manchester/Pt.Arena Guidiville

Through rental assistance funds, Northern Circle Indian Housing Authority will pay a portion of the monthly rent based on housing income. Tenants pay a portion of rent based on a percentage of household income. There are income deductions for dependents, elderly, and disabled families.
