

**BERRY CREEK
PROPOSED
COMMUNITY RULES AND REGULATIONS**

(All changes from the original rules and regulations are in **bold lettering**)

Speed limit within housing community is 10 m.p.h.

Inoperable vehicles on leased property will be strictly prohibited. Non-running vehicles left in the area over 90 days will be considered as abandoned.

Extensions will be consistent with Northern Circle's Inoperable Vehicle Policy.

No firearms shall be discharged within the housing community.

Noise must be kept at acceptable levels at all times using common sense and respect for neighbors. **No loud music after 10:00 p.m. – If your neighbor can hear it from their home ... it's too loud.**

Absolutely NO livestock such as cows, horses, goats or other animals of a similar nature.

Pets will be allowed in the housing community but must be kept on a lease or confined to the resident's yard. Pets are limited to 2 pets per household. (i.e. 1 cat, 1 dog, or 2 dogs and 2 cats)

For the safety of the community it is mandatory that all pets have rabies shots with copies of shot records on file at the Tribal Office.

No parking in areas designated as restricted by the Tribal Council.

It is expressly prohibited for any tenant or their guest to engage in illegal conduct that impairs the physical or social environment of the community. **All Residents are responsible for their guest's behavior with respect to these rules and regulations.**

10:00 Curfew: All children under the age of 18 will be required to be within the vicinity of their home (in the house or yard) after the hour of 10:00 unless under the supervision of an adult.
